Actions 2015/16 Financial Year

- Continued representation and watching brief on our Highways
- Continues representation and watching brief of building works in Terlings Park

On-Going Actions

- Highways management – in collaboration with ECC Highways
- Consideration and response to consultations on issues specifically affecting the parish now and in the future
- Respond to all planning consultations.
- Work with the new residents of Terlings Park as they settle in to here new homes.
- Invite all village organisations and groups to the Annual Parish Meetings and Full Council meetings.
- Keep all village message boards up to date
- Regular content provided to Parish Magazine detailing council activity
- Control and management of parish council finances.
- Produce and ensure appropriate training programme for Clerk and Councillors.
- Installation and maintenance of our War Memorials and Village Planters.
